

HCA K5 & Elementary Attire Guidelines

PLEASE CLEARLY LABEL ALL CLOTHING

All K5 and elementary students are required to wear uniforms purchased from Prep Connection. Shirts should be neatly tucked in with at least one button done up. Belts should be worn with shorts and pants. Girls' shorts and skorts must be at least finger-tip length.



Shoes

Students will wear closed shoes at all times, including regular school days, non-uniform days, and field-trips. Shoes with only a strap in the back will not be permitted.

Boys' Hair and Accessories

Hair should be neatly cut. Hair may just touch the top of the collar, must be off the eyebrows, and can be no longer than the middle of the ear. Hair cut unproportionally in back, sides, or top is unacceptable. The administration reserves the right to determine whether or not a particular style is acceptable. The use of jewelry for boys is at the discretion of the administration. Boys may not wear earrings to school or school functions.



Cold Weather Attire

Please plan ahead for cold weather attire which does NOT include blue jeans this year. Students should be in regular HCA uniforms each school day unless otherwise announced. Uniform long pants are available from Prep Connection and may be worn at any time. Girls are welcome to wear tights with their uniform shorts or skorts. Tights must be school colors which are blue, gray, white, or black.

Jackets / Sweatshirt

Students will only wear HCA jackets and sweatshirts, available at Prep Connection and the Elementary Office. (Warmer non-uniform jackets or coats may only be worn on very cold days when HCA jackets or sweatshirts do not provide enough warmth.)



Blue Jeans Days

On announced Jeans Days, students will follow these guidelines:

- Girls may wear blue jeans, blue jean capris, or blue jean shorts (at least fingertip length) which are neat, modest, and not torn. (No hip-huggers, sweatpants, or very tight jeans.)
- Boys may wear blue jeans or blue jean shorts which are neat and not torn. (No sweat or track pants.)
- Students may wear HCA tops of any kind (HCA uniforms, HCA camp shirts, HCA football shirts, etc.). Length of tops must be such that they will remain tucked in when arms are raised.
- Of course, regular school uniforms may be worn at any time.

Non-Uniform Day Attire

Non-Uniform Days will be announced occasionally. See reverse for guidelines.

HCA Elementary Boys



On Non-Uniform (Casual) Days, elementary boys may wear neat pants or jeans (not faded or torn), shorts, casual shirts, Christian themed t-shirts, and t-shirts without offensive decorations. Boys may not wear sweat or track pants, tank tops, or jerseys. Shorts/pants must fit neatly around the waist, not hanging off. Of course, uniform shorts and/or shirts may also be worn.

HCA Elementary Girls



Girls may wear neat and modest clothing, including casual shirts, slacks, jeans, capris, and shorts/skorts (finger-tip length or longer). No spandex/stretch pants, sweatpants, cheerleading/Soffee shorts, tank tops, spaghetti straps, halter tops, offensive advertising, or stomachs showing. We do not recommend skirts (due to recess and P.E. activities). However, if worn, all skirts must be within two inches of the top of the knee. Of course, uniform shorts and/or tops may also be worn.
