Fall

1. Register For the SAT or ACT Early (if needed)
2. Narrow Your List of Colleges to 4-6
3. Get Application and Financial Aid Information from Each
4. Make a Master Calendar: note test dates, fees, deadlines, college application due dates, financial aid deadlines, letters of recommendation and transcript due dates
5. Ask for Recommendations. Give Each Person Any Required Forms with a Stamped and Addressed Envelope
6. Use Can Use Scholarship Search at collegeboard.com

Winter

1. Check Application Deadlines (most are due between January 1st and February 15)
2. Have HCA Send Your Transcripts to Colleges
3. Contact Colleges to Make Sure They Have Received Your Information
4. Apply For Financial Aid Early and Right: Males 18 and over must have registered for Selective Service to receive federal aid

Spring

1. Letters Will Start Arriving
2. Be in Prayer About Where God Wants You to Attend
3. Compare Financial Aid Packages. Talk To the College Financial Aid Officers If Package is Not Enough
4. Be Prepared To Make Your Final Choice. Send Deposit.

Summer

1. Have HCA Send Final Transcript
2. Start Preparing For Next Year
3. Continue To Be In Prayer
